# How to calculate Annual Attendance Rate

## EXAMPLE

- Instructional Days = 220
- Total Annual Attendance of students in Class-VI = 9850  
(Boys=30, Girls=20, Total=50)
- Annual Attendance of Class-VI Boys = 6200

$$\text{Average Annual Rate} = \frac{\text{Total Annual Attendance of Boys / Girls}}{\text{Total No. of Boys / Girls} \times \text{Annual Instructional Days}} \times 100$$

$$\text{Class VI Boys} = \frac{6200}{30 \times 220} \times 100 = 93.94$$
