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
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



How to calculate Annual Attendance Rate

EXAMPLE

- Instructional Days = $\frac{220}{}$
- Total Annual Attendance of students in Class-VI = 9850 (Boys=30, Girls=20, Total=50)
- Annual Attendance of Class-VI Boys = 6200

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Average Annual Rate = Total Annual Attendance of Boys / Girls

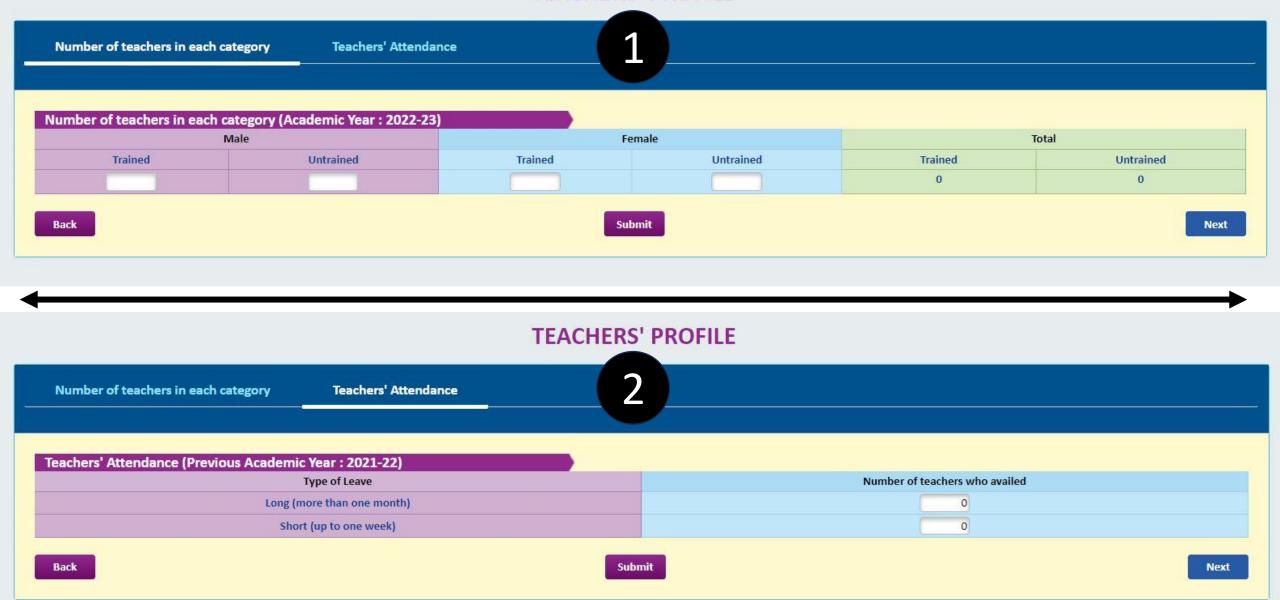
